The Edward Said National Conservatory of Music in Palestine has the following vacancy for full-time music teachers for the **2010/2011** academic year:

Clarinet/Saxophone teachers

The applicants should be well qualified and hold either conservatory or university degrees in their instruments. Teaching experience is also a must. The teacher would teach students of different age groups from approximately 8 to 22 years of age. The work starts **September 1st 2010** and finishes **July 20th 2011**, with the possibility of extension upon the agreement of both parties.

The **ESNCM** pays the teacher a monthly salary including accommodation costs of NIS (5200) plus a \$ (500) one-time payment paid upon arrival as a reinstallation cost, plus an annual round-trip air ticket from the teacher's home country, health insurance, in addition to covering costs of visa renewal if applicable.
