

Het Residentie Orkest

Since September 2005 Maestro Neeme Järvi is chief-conductor of The Hague Philharmonic (Residentie Orkest). The orchestra employs 124 people of whom 102 are musicians. The Dr Anton Philips Hall in The Hague serves as the orchestra's home base. In addition to giving concerts in The Hague the orchestra frequently performs not only in the Netherlands but also abroad and regularly produces CD recordings.

- | Orchestral excerpts

- | Citizens of other countries on the condition that they possess an unrestricted Dutch residence- and work permit.
