Strong French horn player, for solo and tutti, with obligation for natural horn

Required pieces:

Richard Strauss, Horn Concerto No.1, 1st movement.

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, Horn Concerto No.4, 1st movement with cadenza and 2nd movement

Self programmed work for natural horn. Free pick.

If you should happen to be an improviser, at any level, feel free to show us your improvisational skills as well. Free pick.
