ORCHESTRA AUDITION

Principal Flutist

On Tuesday, 9th of November and evt. Wednesday, 10th of November 2010 an audition is scheduled for a position in the Royal Danish Orchestra as a principal Flutist.

The vacancy is to be filled as per 1st of January 2010 or according to agreement.

The audition pieces to be played are as follows:

1. W.A. Mozart: Concerto in G-Major or D-Major, with Cadenzas
2. Carl Nielsen or Jacques Ibert, Concerto for Flute
3. Orchestral excerpts (can be downloaded on www.kglteater.dk approx. 2 weeks before the audition)

Employment will be according to the collective agreement between the Royal Danish Orchestra and CO II. The first year of employment is on a trial basis and may be cancelled subject to one month's mutual notice.

The Royal Theatre reserves the right to select and invite applicants for the audition.

The salary is fixed by seniority and ranges from DKK 24.987,08 up to DKK 34.439,08 per month (level 01.04.2010). If the seniority is less than 6 years, a supplement of DKK 2151,66 per month is granted. Furthermore, a supplement of DKK 6183,80 pro (level 01.04.2010) is granted

For applicants outside the EU countries it is a precondition that at the time of employment the applicant has arranged for work- and residence permit in Denmark.
