Principal horn

The horn section of the Aarhus Symphony Orchestra comprises five horn players, of which two are equally ranked principal horns – both occasionally playing 3rd horn.

The audition consists of four rounds taking place 16 and 17 April 2010

at the Symphonic Concert Hall at Musikhuset Aarhus (Concert Hall Aarhus), Skovgaardsgade 2C, DK-8000 Aarhus C, Denmark.

The Aarhus Symphony Orchestra will provide a pianist on the day of the audition, but travelling expenses and expenses for accommodation must be met by the applicant.

Required:

16 April:

1st round : Mozart: Horn concerto no. 4 – 1st and 2nd movements with cadenza
- plus possibly orchestral excerpts

2nd round: Richard Strauss: Horn concerto no. 1 – the entire concerto
– plus possibly orchestral excerpts

3rd round: Excerpts of orchestral literature and playing with the horn section.

17 April:

4th round: Playing with the orchestra.

Orchestral excerpts and repertoire for 3rd and 4th rounds will be sent to the applicants after the closing date for applications.

SALARY:

Salary pursuant to the current agreements between the musicians' union and the Danish regional symphony orchestras.

NB: Candidates are asked to keep themselves informed as to the current rules and regulations concerning work permit in Denmark.

Closing date for applications: 18 March 2010.

Only applications on application forms will be accepted.
