Substitute Violin teacher (Ramallah)

The applicants should be well qualified and hold either conservatory or university degrees in their instruments. Teaching experience is also a must. The teacher would teach students of different age groups from approximately 8 to 22 years of age. The work starts **April 1st 2010** and finishes **June 30th 2010**.

Working hours: Twenty two (22) teaching hours.

The ESNMCM pays the teacher a monthly salary including accommodation costs of **NIS (5200)** plus a round-trip air ticket from the teacher's home country and health insurance.
