The Orchestre de Bretagne is a full-time symphony orchestra made up of 47 musicians and an administrative team of 12 employees, based in Rennes, France. An ensemble known for its quality on the national level, it constitutes one of the principal permanent artistic forces in Brittany.

Its essential mission is to expose the widest possible audience, over the whole Breton territory, to the musical heritage as well as to today's music, through the exploration of a varied repertoire and the crossing of different forms, aesthetics and disciplines. It thus offers a symphonic season in Rennes and surrounding region, and participates in the Rennes Opera season, averaging four or five productions annually. It must contribute to artistic education in all its forms through musical projects. Open to contemporary creation, it provides support and expertise in training young professionals.

The Orchestre de Bretagne has an overall budget of 4.7M euros, and has authority to become a Public Cultural Cooperation Establishment (EPCC) in the medium term.

The future general manager is a confirmed professional in live-entertainment, in particular musical, with significant experience either in the direction of a top-level musical ensemble or in managing a major cultural facility. Great receptiveness, solid managerial skills and mastery of French and English are indispensable.

Applications from a management team (combining a musical director and administrator) will be considered by the pre-selection application committee.
