ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The LPO is a full-time orchestra with a thirty-six-week season that includes classics, pops, opera, and education concerts, along with an assortment of other types of concerts. Salary for the 2026-2027 season has yet to be determined; the current salary is \$30,606. The LPO provides a generous benefits package which includes fully paid major medical group insurance, paid instrument insurance, life insurance, disability insurance, and contributions to the AFM union pension plan.

Employment of the successful candidate is expected to begin **September 7, 2026**.
