The PNB Orchestra is a per service orchestra. Employment benefits include access to health, dental and vision insurance plans. There is also a 401K plan.

Employment will begin at the earliest availability of the winning candidate. For the 2025-2026 season, Principal rates will be \$315.17 for each 2.5-hour service and \$378.21 for each 3-hour service.

There are six Repertory productions per season plus Nutcracker. There are on average 9 services per Repertory production and approximately 40 Nutcracker services.

The season usually runs from mid-September to early June. Repertory productions are typically scheduled within a two-week framework. Nutcracker starts in late November and finishes at the end of December. All players are required to play a minimum of 70% of Nutcracker services but can opt to play all services.
