Your duties

- You teach the "Acoustics" courses, particularly in the artistic and artistic-pedagogical Bachelor's degree programs. The course content includes
 - Basic knowledge: Physical basics, musical acoustics, physiological acoustics (sound perception, information processing in the brain, psychoacoustics etc.)
 - Historical sound carrier development
 - Room acoustics (basics of geometric and statistical room acoustics, acoustic room design, acoustic concepts in comparison, acoustic analysis of concert halls)
 - Instrumental acoustics
 - electroacoustic media (signal flow and components of a sound system, analog vs. digital technology, comparison of recording methods)


