Position:

Lessons take place on Saturdays between 9am and 5pm.

- A relevant music degree, ideally gained at a music conservatoire (or similar)
- Strong experience of teaching Kodály musicianship. Formal Kodály training is required and a Kodály teaching certification would be a plus.
- A passion for pedagogy, with an ability to inspire and motivate the students, bringing joy and energy to every lesson while driving meaningful progress.
- Experience of teaching groups of young children, ages 4 to 6
- Energetic, punctual, organised, and able to work as part of a team
- Excellent oral communication skills
- Relevant safeguarding training
