Preliminary auditions may continue Tuesday, February 3, 2026. The excerpts will be identical for all candidates. The Final Auditions will start Tuesday, February 3, 2026, after the Preliminary Auditions. As part of the Final Audition, candidates may be required to return to Seattle later, to perform with the Orchestra led by the Music Director.

The PNB Orchestra is a per service orchestra. Employment benefits include access to health, dental and vision insurance plans. There is also a 401K plan.

Employment will begin at the earliest availability of the winning candidate. For the 2025-2026 season, Assistant Principal rates are \$266.99 for each 2.5-hour service and \$320.40 for each 3-hour service.

There are six Repertory productions per season plus Nutcracker. There are on average 9 services per Repertory production and approximately 40 Nutcracker services.

The season usually runs from mid-September to early June. Repertory productions are typically scheduled within a two-week framework. Nutcracker starts in late November and finishes at the end of December. All players are required to play a minimum of 70% of Nutcracker services but can opt to play all services.
