Requirements for Applicants:

- Conservatory or university degree in their discipline.
- Teaching experience and understanding of both individual and group pedagogy.
- Motivated, creative, adaptable, comfortable in group or individual setting.
- Organized, with proven ability to manage a full teaching program.
- Passionate about bringing musical awareness to a community, developing a love of music and enjoyment of playing, inspiring young people.
- Ability to coach orchestra sections, and lead workshops.

Job Description:

- Teaching students aged 7- 22 at one or more of the ESNM branches, covering beginners to college application level.
- Developing String department at the ESNM.
- Participating in weekly student concerts, orchestras and any other musical program in the conservatory.
- Teaching 22 -25 weekly hours plus office hours and academic work.
- The offer may be extended beyond the above – mentioned period upon mutual agreement between the teacher and the ESNM.
- The ESNM covers the cost of one round trip per year between the teacher's country of origin and Palestine as well as visa costs and local health insurance. Other benefits can be discussed with short listed candidates during interviews.
