Piano/Keyboard Audition Procedure:

All applicants must register with the Auditions Supervisor by e-mailing the applicant fact sheet and one page resume prior to auditioning. Please bring to the audition your own copies of music and backing tracks. Pianists/Keyboardists auditioning for U.S. Navy Fleet Bands must perform on piano, keyboard, or a combination of both instruments. A Yamaha MX-88 keyboard will be provided. A small speaker will be provided for backing tracks and a PA speaker with XLR and 1/4" inputs will be provided for instruments. A keyboard will be provided. Our auditions are designed to represent a variety of musical styles that you could potentially perform in a Fleet Band.

Parking: There are several public parking options within a 5-minute walk to the audition site. Parking at the hotel is valet only and is \$17.50 for 3 hours.

Prescreens are available but not mandatory. Based on a limited amount of audition slots, a prescreen may be required. Please contact the Auditions Team for prescreen submission details.

Please bring with you to your audition:

Your own copies of music and backing tracks.

Pianists/Keyboardists must perform a total of seven selections from the following six categories. A minimum of three selections must be performed with backing tracks provided by the applicant:

- 1. Current/Popular (one selection):** perform any hit song from the last two years
- 2. Country (one selection)**
- 3. R&B/Funk/Soul (one selection)**
- 4. Rock/Alternative (one selection)**
- 5. Jazz (two selections):** one swing and one Latin selection
- 6. Classical (one selection)**

Sight-reading is required. The applicant will read from a Real/Fake Book and should be prepared to sight-read a blues, swing and Latin selection. The applicant will be asked to play the head, comp the changes, and perform an improvised solo.
