#### ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL MUSICIANS (STRINGS)

General duties and work requirements of an Assistant (Sub) Principal musician are to:

- · work in accordance with the terms of this agreement, and
- play the instrument(s) for which the musician was auditioned.

In addition to section musicians' duties, Assistant Principal musicians will also:

- prepare and play relevant solos;
- assist the Section Principal and Associate Principal in managing the section and
- preparing parts;
- share the musical responsibilities of the section and lead the section when required;
- sit on the front or second desk or in another place as required.
