

The Netherlands Radio Choir is the symphonic choir of the Netherlands. With its powerful, rich sound, the choir usually performs in both large and small ensembles, almost always together with orchestra. Permanent partner is the Netherlands' own Radio Philharmonic Orchestra (RFO), but collaborations with top orchestras such as the Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra and the Rotterdam Philharmonic Orchestra are also common practice.

As a symphonic choir, the emphasis of the repertoire is on the great works of the 19th, 20th and 21st centuries. The choir covers a broad palette: from Baroque to contemporary, from a cappella works to grand symphonies and oratorios. The strength of the Netherlands Radio Choir lies in its ability to switch effortlessly between styles and line-ups.

Working with the Netherlands Radio Choir requires excellent vocal technique and a high degree of flexibility to match the dynamics and versatility of the symphonic repertoire.

The choir is part of Stichting Omroep Muziek and closely associated with the Dutch Public Broadcasting Corporation. Most of its concerts take place in the concert series NTR Zaterdag Matinee, Het Zondagochtend Concert and the AVROTROS Vrijdagconcert. These concerts are usually broadcast live on NPO Klassiek.

Since September 2020, the young English conductor Benjamin Goodson has been chief conductor of The Netherlands Radio Choir. Upon his appointment, he said, *"From our first project together, I felt a genuine connection with this great ensemble. For me, the choir is defined by the intensity of its sound, by its humanity. I look forward to working together, discovering new repertoire and exploring new ways to connect audiences to us."*

Applications will be accepted until May 18, 2026.

Applicants should have experience singing choral music at the highest level, have a relevant professional education, preferably at the conservatory, completed with a master's degree in voice. In addition, the applicant should be open to personal, professional development.

A pre-selection will take place following the application. Candidates will receive an invitation for the selection audition. On the basis of this selection audition it will be determined directly whether the candidate will be invited for the final audition, or has been found suitable to be invited as a substitute.

The final audition will determine a possible employment contract with Stichting Omroep Muziek.

Remuneration

A full-time position (36 hours per week) commands a salary ranging between € 3.353,05 and € 4.828,18 gross per month, excl. 8% holiday bonus and a year-end bonus of € 1.500,00 gross. Full and enthusiastic commitment to the choir and its development is of course essential. Nevertheless, there is also scope to continue solo and freelance work alongside this role.
