

## TEACHING POSITIONS, MUSIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

As part of a broad mission to expand its leadership position in the 21<sup>st</sup> century, The Juilliard School embarked upon an ambitious plan to open access to its expertise on a global scale through interrelated site-based initiatives. Establishing a presence in the People's Republic of China is an important part of this endeavor.

The Tianjin Juilliard School (TJS) is the first branch of an innovative initiative within this global objective. Approved by the Ministry of Education in China, TJS welcomed its first class of pre-college students in the 2019 academic year, and the graduate class in Fall 2020. TJS's Public Education Division serves the general public by offering lessons, classes, workshops, and other programs for students ranging from young children through adults.

### **Description:**

The Tianjin Juilliard School's Public Education Division is seeking qualified applicants for its Music Development Program in instrumental (applied) teaching in the areas of piano, violin, viola, cello, double bass, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, French horn, trumpet, trombone, percussion, harp, and composition. These teaching positions are for the Music Development Program only, not the Pre-College or Graduate programs.

The Music Development Program will offer individual lessons to students ages 5-18 who show strong musical potential and have reached the level of advanced beginner or higher. MDP Students will have varied goals ranging from preparation for the TJS Pre-College audition to general music enrichment. Regardless of the goal, MDP faculty must always uphold the highest standards in pedagogy synonymous with the Juilliard name. Teaching will take place on our Binhai Campus in Tianjin, China.

- Experience teaching younger age groups
- Openness to Western ideas about music education is essential
- Experience teaching or studying in overseas institutions preferred
- Fluency in Mandarin (required) and English (preferred)
- Weekend availability essential; teaching on other days possible
