In this comprehensive program, the instructor will offer a wide array of methodological tools suitable for any skill level. The range of musical expression will be expanded with associative methods and personality development techniques.
Participants will be able to enhance their expression of the narrative and drama of music by mastering the art of conveying the gestures and characters of the musical piece. With practice techniques focusing on in-the-moment, participants will learn to overcome any stage fright-related attention issues. Each participant will receive personalized training tailored to their unique needs, ensuring a valuable educational experience. The course ends with a concert with the participants conducting.

IMPROVEMENT OF CONDUCTING TECHNIQUE

The course is designed to improve conducting techniques, and participants will be provided with opportunities, methods, and exercises to develop expressive and efficient conducting movements. Some participants might feel that their current technique requires correction; the course will equip them with conducting etudes which they can continue practicing independently even after the course concludes.

IMPROVEMENT OF REHEARSAL TECHNIQUE

IMPROVEMENT OF MUSICAL EXPRESSIONS

The course dedicates significant attention to broadening the participants' musical range and expression. With associative methods and personality development techniques will be used by the course leader to help participants dive deeply into the emotional and narrative meaning of music, enhancing their ability to express it more vividly.

IMPROVEMENT OF COMMUNICATION SKILLS

The course will be held in a friendly, warm environment, collaborating with a supportive orchestra. This will help participants improve their cooperation and communication. They will learn how to develop a good relationship with the orchestra, other people, and to communicate effectively to achieve their musical vision.

PERSONALIZED TRAINING

Each participant will receive personalized training tailored to their unique needs. The masterclass will address the needs and improvement areas of each participant, helping them progress. Each participant will receive continuous feedback as we monitor the steps of their development. All active participants will have the opportunity to perform at the final concert in Goldmark Hall Budapest. The movements to be conducted at the concert will be chosen by the course leader.
