



The prominent Czech conductor, pedagogue and violoncellist Tomáš Koutník is one of the most highly respected pedagogical personalities in Europe.

He began his career in the **Czech Philharmonic as** assistant to conductor Václav Neumann. Thanks to his extraordinary abilities he has become one of the **most prestigious Czech conductors**. Listing of his successful career includes guest engagements in many countries around the world. As a highly respected conductor, he is now focusing on the development of the most talented international conductors.

He completed his conducting and cello studies at the Academy of Performing Arts in Prague. Shortly afterwards he won the most prestigious conducting competition in Europe, The International Besançon Competition. This success launched his career.
