## **ZOHRAB TADEVOSYAN**

### **Violinist & International Pedagogue**

Tadevosyan is an internationally recognized violin pedagogue whose career combines artistic excellence with a deep commitment to the development of young musicians.

For more than a decade, he served as assistant to the legendary violin professor Ana Chumachenco, one of the most influential pedagogues of the modern violin school. This close collaboration allowed him to develop a refined pedagogical approach deeply rooted in the great European violin tradition. Between 2010 and 2020, he taught at the Escuela Superior de Música Reina Sofía in Madrid, contributing to the development of one of Europe's most prestigious violin programs. During the same period he was also professor of violin at the Centro Superior Katarina Gurska (2012-2020).

Since October 2024, he has been Guest Professor at the Leopold Mozart Center of the University of Augsburg, where he continues to share his pedagogical vision with young violinists.

Tadevosyan is also a highly respected international jury member. In 2024, he served as President of the Jury of the Aram Khachaturian International Violin Competition.

He has also been invited as jury member in competitions such as:

- Louis Spohr International Violin Competition - Weimar
- Aram Khachaturian International Violin Competition - Yerevan
- Joseph Joachim International Violin Competition - Hannover

He regularly gives masterclasses and lectures at international academies and festivals including the Swiss International Music Academy and the Mozarteum International Summer Academy in Salzburg.

Committed to the global development of young musicians, he also maintains an active pedagogical presence in Japan, where he regularly gives masterclasses and educational projects.

Through his teaching, masterclasses and artistic collaborations, Zohrab Tadevosyan continues to influence a new generation of violinists.
