

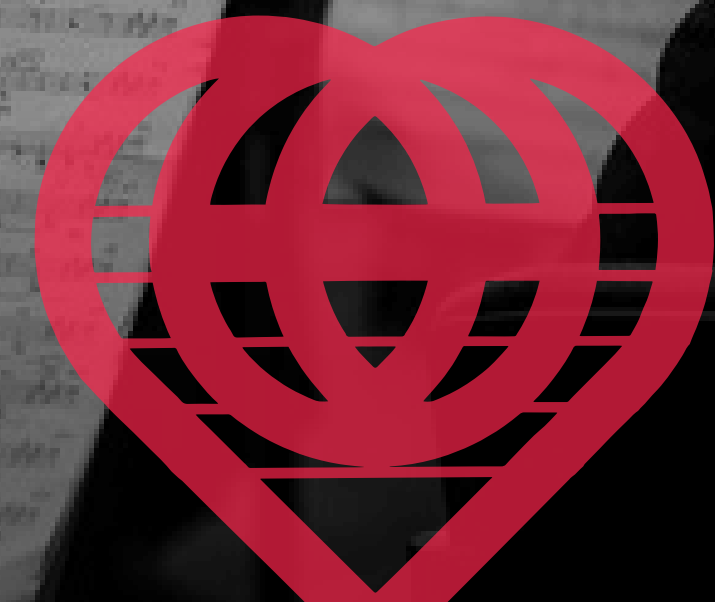


JM World Orchestra

After a successful pilot edition in 2025, the **JM World Orchestra** is officially back and looking for exceptionally talented, young, professional musicians, between the **ages of 18 and 30**, for a unique chamber orchestra session in **Granada, Spain, from 28th of August to 5th of September 2026**. The orchestra will be led by **David Fernández Caravaca**, one of the most compelling emerging conductors of his generation, and including a performance at the Alhambra, the exquisite palace of Charles V.

The **JM World Orchestra** is an international ensemble for **young professional musicians (18–30)**, bringing together outstanding talent from across the globe in a spirit of **collaboration, excellence, and cultural exchange.**

Recognised for his expressive style and musical depth, **David Fernández Caravaca** is establishing himself on the European conducting scene.

Winner of the **Juventudes Musicales de España Conducting Competition (2023)**, he has worked with leading orchestras including the **Orquesta Sinfónica de Tenerife, RTVE Symphony Orchestra, and Real Orquesta Sinfónica de Sevilla.**

He has collaborated with renowned conductors such as **Vasily Petrenko** and **Elim Chan**, and continues to build an international career shaped by versatility and a strong artistic identity.

Currently Principal Conductor of the Córdoba Youth Orchestra, he brings energy, clarity, and a dynamic artistic vision to the JM World Orchestra 2026, leading a new generation of musicians in an inspiring musical experience.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The selected musicians will be part of an **intensive rehearsal programme** that presents an exciting opportunity for collaboration and artistic growth in a multicultural environment. You will receive the music sheet one month before the sessions, so please arrive prepared.

The session will culminate in **two live concert performances on the 3rd and 4th of September.**

Profile & Requirements

- You should be aged between 18 and 30 years old.
- You should be a classically trained musician specialised in one of the following instruments: **Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Flute, Oboe, Bassoon, Clarinet, French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba, and Percussion.**
- You should prepare and submit one or two video recordings (10-20 minutes in total).
- You should submit a short **CV** highlighting your musical experience and achievements.
- You should include a **letter of motivation** explaining why you want to join.
- Bring your instrument!

Conditions

- **Participants cover** their own flights + personal & instrument insurance.
- **Recommendation:** Seek funding from your national JMI member.
- Accommodation, meals, and local transportation are **fully provided**.
- **No application fee** (but cancellation fee may apply)
