

ALESSANDRA VISENTIN - CONTRALTO -

One of the most fascinating voices on today's opera and concert stages, acclaimed by critics especially for the rarity of her voice type.

In november 2022 The Italian Academy Foundation recognized her as one of the top level italian artist, one of the most outstanding exponents of Italianita' and of the classical artistry of the contralto.

Alessandra Visentin has appeared in some of the world's most prestigious venues and festivals, among them the Teatro alla Scala Milan, Teatro San Carlo Naples, Carnegie Hall New York, Musikverein Wien, Auditorium Nacional de Musica Madrid, Halle aux Grains Toulouse, Grand Warner Brothers Theatre (USA), Théâtre des Champs-Élysées de Paris, Opera Royal de Versailles, Salzburg Festival, Theater Basel, Brucknerhaus Linz, Ravenna Festival, Festival Anima Mundi, Teatro del Maggio Musicale Fiorentino Florence, Festival of Macerata, Teatro Luciano Pavarotti Modena, Opera de Reims, Festival Opera Rara and Misteria Paschalia Krakow, Umbria Musicfest, and the Performing Arts Center in Seoul, South Korea.

Ms. Visentin has worked with renowned conductors such as Riccardo Muti, Zubin Mehta, Riccardo Chailly, Franz Welser Most, Ken David Masur, Juraj Valcuha, Salvatore Di Vittorio, Gabriele Ferro, Riccardo Frizza, Gianluca Martinenghi, Andrea Marcon, Christopher Hogwood, Marc Minkowski, Jean-Claude Malgoire, Ottavio Dantone, Federico Maria Sardelli, Claudio Scimone and with stage directors such as Robert Carsen, Ferzan Ozpetek, David Poutney, Pier Luigi Pizzi, Hugo de Ana, Sven-Eric Bechtolf, Emilio Sagi, Alessio Pizzech, Massimo Gasparon, Christian Schiaretti, Pierfrancesco Maestrini.

She studied at the Giuseppe Verdi Conservatory of Music and the Claudio Abbado Civic School of Music in Milan.

A pupil of renewed contraltos Bernadette Manca di Nissa and Sara Mingardo she also studied with Bob Kettelson and Regina Resnik.

She is the winner of several international competition among them the European Community Voice Competition at the Teatro del Maggio Musicale Fiorentino's Academy for young singers in Florence.
