

The renowned violinist NELLI SHKOLNIKOVA taught for many years at Indiana University, Bloomington. Her unique style of teaching is recognized worldwide and produced many wonderful musicians. In homage to Nelli Shkolnikova, her former students continue her legacy by inviting talented and motivated young violinists, violists, and cellists to an intensive string and chamber music retreat at the Chateau de la Flocellière in France from August 5 - 15, 2024.



The Shkolnikova Academy is geared towards students ages 14 through 28; younger students may be accepted upon individual consideration. Applications are open to violin, viola, cello, and limited number of advanced collaborative piano students.

Students at the academy will receive a minimum of 7 individual instrumental lessons, 7 chamber music coachings, and performance opportunities with a professional pianist, as well as invitation to guest masterclasses and workshops. Unique to this academy is the possibility for students to take lessons from all faculty members. Our international faculty members are comprised of musicians in the world's top orchestras and conservatories, allowing students to discover a variety of approaches that stem from the same tradition. The academy also offers workshops in orchestral repertoire, audition preparation, and alternative styles.

Students will be provided room and board and have access to amenities (swimming pool, games, etc.) on the grounds of the magnificent Chateau de la Flocellière in the Vendée region of France.
