Each performance is a unique story, and I encourage you to play not only with technical mastery but with heart and soul, conveying the beauty and depth of music.



Competition Timetable

- February 1st, 2025: Application open
- June 1st, 2025: Deadline for Applications.
- June 5th- 10th, 2025: Competition First (online) round results
- July 1st, 2025: Opening ceremony of Competition Second round
- July 2nd- 4th, 2025: Competition Second round (live performances) and results
- July 5th, 2025: Grand Final Concert and Award ceremony





Rules & Regulations

The competition will be held in two rounds.

- First round: Online participation
- Second round: Live participation

Age Categories

The age of the participant is determined on the day of the start of the competition: June 01, 2025

- Category 1 (Ages 7 to 9)
- Category 2 (Ages 10 to 12)
- Category 3 (Ages 13 to 15)
- Category 4 (Ages 16 to 18)
- Category 5 (Ages 19 to 25)

Make sure you comply fully with the "Video **Requirements**" for the first round. Participants who do not comply with the rules of the course will automatically lose their qualifications for the competition round. The video recordings will be viewed by the jury and a decision will be made as to who is invited to the second round of the competition and will be confirmed by email. The applicant has no right to legally challenge the jury's decision.



Repertoire Requirements for First round

First round consists of online performances for all age categories.

- Upload one video of two pieces different in style/character. One of the pieces must represent the Baroque era.
- There is no time limit for first round.
- Add the link (e.g. a YouTube or Vimeo) in the application form.
- The registration process is complete upon receipt of a completed application form.
- Registration will be confirmed by email.
- By registering, the applicant declares his/her acceptance of the competition rules.

Video Requirements

First round, Online Participation: June 1st, 2025: Deadline for Admission

- The video must clearly show the face and hands of the performer.
- The recording of different musical pieces or movements must be brought together in a single video link. Each of the pieces or movements should be recorded continuously. It should not be edited or have additional sound effects.
- Pieces must be performed from memory.
- An unedited video of the performance forwarded to "GENERALBASS" BMIPC as a YouTube or Vimeo (PUBLIC LINK).
- Please clearly indicate the name of the participant and the name of piece on the Title of the Video.

Baroque Music International Piano Competition

- Each successful participant will be given a mandatory date and time for the performance.
- Participants will have the opportunity to use the provided facilities in order to rehearse.
- The results of the second-final round will determine who participates in the Gala Concert.
- The jury will direct the proceedings in the competition by, for example, selecting the pieces to be played on Gala Concert as well as requesting shorter versions of certain pieces, if necessary.
- All second-round performances of the "GeneralBass" BMIPC will be streamed live on our Facebook page and YouTube channel.



Repertoire Requirements for Second round

The Second round consists of live performances in Yerevan, Armenia, between 2nd and 4th of July, 2025. The venue will be at the Komitas Museum-Institute,

(28 Arshakunyats Ave, Yerevan, Armenia).

- Opening ceremony of Competition Second round will take place on the July 1st, at 6 p.m.
- The competition auditions will take place July 2nd to July 4th, 2025, starting at 10 a.m.
- Grand Final Concert and Award ceremony will take place on the July 5th, 2025, at 6 p.m.

Time limit for second round. Age categories:

- Category 1 (Ages 7 to 9): Up to 10 min.
- Category 2 (Ages 10 to 12): Up to 12 min.
- Category 3 (Ages 13 to 15): Up to 15 min.
- Category 4 (Ages 16 to 18): Up to 20 min.
- Category 5 (Ages 19 to 25): Up to 30 min.



Baroque Music International Piano Competition

Jury Members

- The jury consists of five professional and experienced artists, concert pianists and educators from different countries.
- The jury members are not allowed to participate in the evaluation of their students' performance.
- Names of jury members will be published one month before the start of the competition.

Judgement Criteria

- In judging the performances, equal weighting will be given to the overall musical impression and precisely reciting the piece exactly as written.
- Additional factors considered include the difficulty of the piece as well as the energy and charisma transmitted by the performer and the player's technical abilities.



For age categories 1-3

- Choose <u>two</u> pieces from the following periods:
- One of the pieces must represent the Baroque era.
- Pieces must be performed from memory.
- You can repeat first round repertoire, or change it.

Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impression, Contemporary (up to present day)

For age categories 4-5

- Choose <u>three</u> pieces from the following periods:
- Pieces must be selected from different musical periods and performed from memory.
- One of the pieces must represent the Baroque era.
- You can repeat first round repertoire, or change it.

Important Notes

- All competition participants or their legal guardians shall bear all expenses related to their participation in the competition.
- The organizer retains the right to create photo, video, and audio recordings during the competition and the Gala concert and to use recorded material for advertising purposes.
- Parents or legal guardians of participants under 18, upon registration, automatically give consent to the organizer of the competition to use the names of participants, artist biographies, photos and videos on the websites and social networks of GeneralBass BMIPC



Grand Final Concert and Award Ceremony

The award ceremony will be held as a public concert with the participation of the winners and jury selected participants on July 5th, 2025, at the State Philharmonia of Armenia, Arno Babajanyan Concert Hall. (2 Abovyan Street in Yerevan, Armenia)

- Participation in the Gala Concert is obligatory for the winners of the Grand Prizes and First prizes. If possible, the Special prize winners will also play in the Gala concert.
- All prizes will be presented during the Gala Concert at the Awards Ceremony. The respective prize money will be transferred to an account to be specified.
- Prizes must be claimed in person at the ceremony; they will not be mailed.

Professors who prepared "GRAND PRIZE" winners will be acknowledged with certificates for outstanding results and preparation of Winner, exellent application of the highest pedagogical standards and methods and Cash Prizes.

- For age category 1: Cash Prize 100 USD equivalent AMD, Medal, Certificate
- For age category 2: Cash Prize 200 USD equivalent AMD, Medal, Certificate
- For age category 3: Cash Prize 300 USD equivalent AMD, Medal, Certificate
- For age category 4: Cash Prize 400 USD equivalent AMD, Medal, Certificate
- For age category 5: Cash Prize 500 USD equivalent AMD, Medal, Certificate

- The students who received "FIRST PRIZE" will be awarded with certificates, medals and monetary rewards.
- All professors who prepared the "FIRST PRIZE" winners will be acknowledged with certificate for exellent application of the highest pedagogical standards and methods and monetary rewards.
- "SECOND PRIZE" will be awarded to competitors who obtain at least 91-95 points.
- "THIRD PRIZE" will be awarded to competitors who obtain at least 85-90 points.
- The students who received "SECOND PRIZE" and "THIRD PRIZE" will be awarded with certificates and medals.
- All professors who prepared the laureates will be acknowledged with a certificate for their exceptional work and preparation of the laureate.

The masterclasses are divided into different age groups:

- beginners (from 6-10 years)
- young performers (from 10-15 years)
- students (from 15-19 years)

Masterclasses fee:

- beginners: for one lesson, (40 minutes) 10 000 AMD
- young performers: for one lesson, (50 minutes) 15 000 AMD
- students: for one lesson,
 (60 minutes) 20 000 AMD

After registration you will be contacted by our organizators for the decisions about days and hours of the masterclasses.





MASTERCLASSES

"Generalbass" competition organizers offers masterclasses with professional and experienced artists and educators throughout the year.

The masterclasses will be held as individual classes, online and offline.

Languages: English, Russian, Armenian

Musicians with a basic musical background are the target audience for these masterclasses.

The participants will learn about the basics of different musical styles and the traditions from baroque to contemporary music. There will be a possibility to get acquainted with the principles of stage performance in theory and practice.

The amount of masterclasses should be atleast <u>three</u>.
