The employment is indefinite on 100%, with a probation period of 6 months, and begins in August 2019. The work chores consist mainly of ensemble playing but also in orchestra.

Auditions will be held at GotlandsMusiken in Visby, Sweden, 14-15 March 2019.

Mandatory pieces:

- W.A. Mozart: Horn concerto no.4 in Eb major, K. 495, 1st movement (without cadenza)
- R. Schumann: Adagio for horn and piano in Ab major, Op. 70

Day 1 is dedicated to solo auditions with piano accompaniment. Selected applicants will day 2 make an ensemble audition (music scores are distributed in advance).

GotlandsMusiken (GM), one of Sweden's 23 regional music institutions funded mainly by state and region, is Gotland's only regular professional ensemble with 15 full-time musicians for diverse styles of music: jazz quartet • woodwind quintet • brass sextet • GM Orchestra • Visby Big Band.

GM has the regional music assignment, which encompasses community concert activities in schools, health care, local libraries next to public concert series. GM inspires, supports and collaborates with the local music life in the fields of youth and education, amateur music life, freelance professionals and concert organizers. GM carries out app. 320 activities per year for an audience of 30.000 people (2017), predominantly on Gotland.
